Every year, St Michael's reminds all our members that we depend on pledges and contributions for much (50%) of the funds we need to support and maintain our programs, buildings, clergy, and staff and enable our nurturing, spiritual community to continue and to thrive.

Yes, we are a spiritual community. We are much more than salaries and buildings. We are guided by the love of Jesus Christ and by Holy Scripture with our mission to live and proclaim the transforming love of God. We do this in many ways: donating to the Always Open shelf, collecting clothing for those in need, providing meeting places for twelve-step groups, and giving toys to brighten children's Christmases. We also support and encourage each other in a variety of ministries – choir, altar guild, vestry, and bible study groups. Our property committee manages a campus that includes the church, the Rectory, the Community House, five rental units, and the School on the Green and Greenwoods Counseling Referrals in the parish house basement. Our finance committee oversees our investments. These groups work together, seeking and serving Christ in each other.

Of our income, 10% supports the Common Mission of the Episcopal Church in Connecticut and the Anglican Communion throughout the world. Many of the staff and programs of those bodies help us directly here in Litchfield and extend our ministry in ways we cannot.
